

RESOLUTION NO. 353

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH SIEMENS WATER TECHNOLOGIES CORP. REGARDING THE PURCHASE AND DELIVERY OF HYDROGEN SULFIDE/ODOR CONTROL OXIDANT FOR SEWAGE DEWATERING AT THE SEWER DISTRICT

By Public Works Committee:

WHEREAS, As part of the operation of the wastewater treatment plants, the Albany County Sewer District requires the use of hydrogen sulfide/odor control oxidant for proper water treatment, and

WHEREAS, The Sewer District has solicited bids from vendors capable of supplying the quantities of hydrogen sulfide/odor control oxidant necessary for the wastewater treatment plants, and

WHEREAS, The Sewer District has recommended that Siemens Water Technologies Corp., 2650 Tallevast Road, Sarasota, Florida 34243 be awarded the contract as the sole responsible bidder for the delivery of the required hydrogen sulfide/odor control oxidant for 2009 and 2010, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with Siemens Water Technologies Corp. for the delivery of hydrogen sulfide/odor control oxidant to the wastewater treatment plants, on an as needed basis, as determined by the Sewer District, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the agreement shall indicate that the delivery price of the hydrogen sulfide/odor control oxidant shall be no more than \$0.75 per pound and the term of the agreement shall be from January 1, 2009 to December 31, 2010 with a one-year extension clause with the same terms and conditions upon mutual agreement of both parties, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
