

RESOLUTION NO. 218

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NYS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION REGARDING THE WATERVLIET-SHAKER ROAD/OLD NISKAYUNA ROAD/OLD WOLF ROAD ROUNDABOUT PROJECT IN THE TOWN OF COLONIE

WHEREAS, By Resolution No. 201 for 2008, this Honorable Body authorized an agreement with the NYS Department of Transportation (NYSDOT) regarding the shared cost for the Watervliet-Shaker Road/Old Niskayuna Road/Old Wolf Road Roundabout Project in the Town of Colonie, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of Public Works has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with the NYS Department of Transportation regarding expenditures for betterment project costs in accordance with Highway Law Sec. 10(27), and

WHEREAS, NYSDOT has estimated the cost of the work Albany County has requested to be performed as described in a betterment project schedule and the County shall deposit in escrow with the NYS Comptroller, subject to the draft or requisition of the NYSDOT Commissioner, the amount of the cost estimate, to be expended by the NYS Comptroller on the costs of the betterment or the return of the excess amount thereof, if any, to the County, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the aforementioned betterment is approved and the sum of Two hundred seventy five thousand dollars and no cents (\$275,000) is appropriated from H522.R1 for deposit with the State Comptroller pursuant to the agreement, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Albany County Executive is authorized to enter into all necessary agreements or other instruments with the NYS Department of Transportation regarding the Watervliet-Shaker Road/Old Niskayuna Road/Old Wolf Road Roundabout Project in the Town of Colonie, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
