Eligibility: Open to all artists in Upstate New York. All media completed in the last 12 months and not previously shown at a UAG event is permitted. Work must be able to be hand-delivered and picked up on the dates specified. **THE UAG CANNOT STORE WORK!**

Specifications: Entrants are limited only by imagination, but please abide by the following:

- Maximum size of work is 4 ft. (any direction)
- Work must be wired and ready to hang
- Work must be clearly labeled with the artist's name, name of work, contact information, and price.

Entry checklist:

- Completed and signed entry form
- Digital or printed images. Please do not send actual work.

Artists are encouraged to submit a 1-2 page bio, typed and printed or emailed with their entry to advocate112@gmail.com.

Entry procedure and fees: Submissions and submission forms must be received by:

Midnight on September 3rd 2010

Each artist may submit up to 5 pieces. Artists are encouraged to email images and submission form information. Drop off date for accepted work is October 23rd - 24th from 2 to 6 pm. Please direct all electronic submissions and requests for alternate drop-off arrangements to JoLynn Backes (advocate112@gmail.com).

Sales: Although artists may elect to classify their work as "Not For Sale," we encourage you to price your work. The UAG Gallery is a not-for-profit organization and depends on Sales Handling Fees, membership dues, and charitable contributions in order to cover operating expenses.

No pricing changes will be allowed after acceptance.

Artists whose work is sold through the UAG will be charged a Sales Handling Fee of 25% (UAG 25% /Artist 75%).

Works not sold by October 31st must be picked up on October 31st from 2-4PM or by special arrangement.
