

RESOLUTION NO. 1

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NYS INDUSTRIES FOR THE DISABLED REGARDING ANTIQUE FURNITURE RESTORATION FOR THE ALBANY COUNTY COURT HOUSE

By Audit and Finance Committee and Mr. Collins:

WHEREAS, The Albany County Purchasing Agent in cooperation with the Court Facilities Project issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) regarding antique furniture restoration and daily storage fees in connection with the Albany County Court House renovation project, and

WHEREAS, The project bid specified the labor and materials necessary to refurbish an estimated 537 chairs, benches, tables, desks, bookcases, storage cabinets, files and other pieces of furniture, clean 11 pieces and store the furniture, as well as all costs associated with transportation of the furniture and reinstallation, and

WHEREAS, The Albany County Court Facilities Project Office Manager, after consultation with Office Relocation Management, Inc. and the Albany County Attorney, reviewed the proposals of three firms responding to the RFP and recommended awarding the contract for antique furniture restoration and daily storage fees to the New York State Industries for the Disabled, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with the New York State Industries for the Disabled, 155 Washington Avenue, Suite 400, Albany, NY 12210, in an amount not to exceed \$268,779.33, which amount includes \$258,979.33 for antique furniture restoration and no more than \$9,800 at \$50/\$60 per day for storage of the refurbished furniture, if necessary, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
