**A LOCAL LAW OF THE COUNTY OF ALBANY, NEW YORK AMENDING
THE ALBANY COUNTY CHARTER FOR THE PURPOSE OF CLARIFYING
DEPUTY DEPARTMENT HEAD AUTHORITY TO ACT**

By Mr. Houghtaling:

PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 10 AND 33 OF THE MUNICIPAL HOME RULE LAW
AND SECTION 2702 OF THE ALBANY COUNTY CHARTER.

BE IT ENACTED by the Albany County Legislature as follows:

SECTION 1. The Albany County Charter is hereby amended by adding a new subsection (c) to Article 3, Section 308:

Section 308. Appointment of officers and employees

(c) Within appropriations made therefore, the Administrative Head of each Department and Administrative Unit may appoint a deputy who shall be authorized to act for and in place of such Administrative Head in the performance of his/her powers and duties.

SECTION 2. Severability. If any article, section, subsection, paragraph, phrase or sentence of this local law is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, that portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion hereof.

SECTION 3. Effective Date. This Local Law shall take effect March 1, 2007.
